Fuel Adjustment – Monthly Update July 2024

What is the rate? How does it work?

The average price is calculated by Brink's using the average weekly volume weighted retail price, including taxes, of diesel in Canada. This is reported by [The Kent Group](#), a company that provides data on Canada's retail petroleum industry. Customers will see a fuel adjustment charge on their monthly invoice.

Does it impact all Customers?

The Fuel Adjustment will apply to all new customers and all existing customers upon renewal. Exceptions could apply.

As you are aware, Fuel Adjustment is written into all new contracts and into most renewed contracts (exceptions do apply). This charge is a percentage of the customers' total invoice, and adjusted monthly based on changes in the average market price of diesel in Canada.

The current monthly average price is \$1.67

(Last month, the rate was \$1.71 per litre – a decrease of 4¢),

Accordingly, the Fuel Surcharge for July 2024 will be 26.5%. This will be reviewed again on July 15, 2024 based on the 4-week period ending July 14, 2024
